

Application form for a Scholarship for EEA students 2010-2011.

If you are a student from a country belonging to the European Economic Area (a so-called EEA student) or from Surinam or Switzerland, and based on your situation you have to pay the study fees of € 4.000,- (full-time) or € 3.000,- (part-time) in the study year 2010-2011, you may apply for a Scholarship.

A Scholarship amounts to a maximum of € 1.800,- for a full-time study and € 1.300,- for a part-time study. The number of Scholarships is limited. The awarding of concessions takes place on the grounds of the following two criteria: high artistic evaluation on admission and evidence for the need for financial support on the basis of means.

A comparable grant will in principle be given for a maximum of 4 years for a Bachelor course and a maximum of 2 years for a Master course.

With the awarding of this financial concession, the tariff for study fees is:

€ 2.200,- for a full-time and

€ 1.700,- for a part-time course.

In all other cases the tariffs are € 4.000,- and € 3.000,- respectively.

You have to apply well before the start of the academic year, at the latest before the 1st of July 2010. The aim is to award the Scholarships before the 1st of August 2010.

The scholarship will be awarded conditionally, i.e. will be paid after your official enrolment.
